Before you invest in any fund, you should consider how it would work with your other investments and your tolerance for risk.

The mutual fund is an alternative mutual fund. It is permitted to invest in asset classes or use investment strategies that are not permitted for other types of mutual funds. The specific strategies that differentiate this fund from other types of mutual funds include: increased ability to use derivatives for hedging and non-hedging purposes; increased ability to sell securities short; and the ability to borrow cash to use for investment purposes. While these strategies will be used in accordance with the fund’s investment objectives and strategies, during certain market conditions they may accelerate the pace at which your investment decreases in value.

What does the Fund invest in?

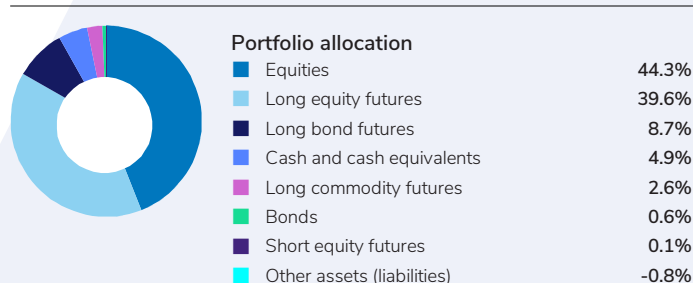
The Fund aims to provide long-term capital growth through exposure to investment strategies permitted by the Rules for alternative mutual funds, by investing primarily in units of other mutual funds and/or through direct investments. Investments are made by allocating assets to a number of mandates, including Global Equity Hedge and Global Macro. Each mandate is separately managed. The Fund’s aggregate exposure is calculated as the sum of the following, and must not exceed 300% of its net asset value: (i) the aggregate market value of securities sold short; (ii) the value of indebtedness under any borrowing arrangements for investment purposes; and (iii) the aggregate notional value of the Fund’s specified derivatives positions excluding any specified derivatives used for hedging purposes.

The charts below give you a snapshot of the Fund’s investments on March 31, 2026. The Fund’s investments may change.

How risky is it?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money. One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund’s returns change over time. This is called “volatility”.

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

No guarantees

Like most mutual funds, this Fund doesn’t have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

Risk rating

IG Wealth Management has rated the volatility of this Fund as **low to medium**.

This rating is based on how much the Fund’s returns have changed from year to year. It doesn’t tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.

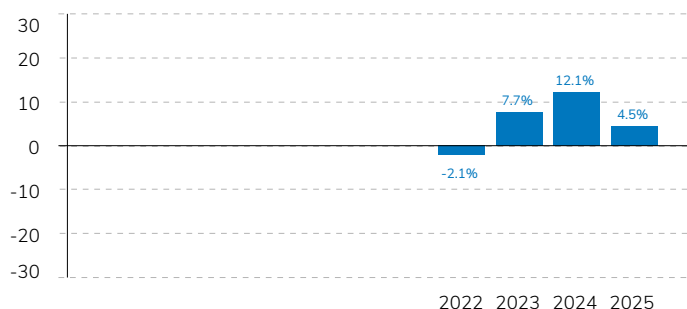

How has the Fund performed?

This section tells you how Series I securities of the Fund have performed over the past 4 years. Returns are after Fund expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the Fund's returns.

Year-by-year returns

This chart shows how Series I securities of the Fund performed in each of the past 4 years. The Fund dropped in value in 1 of the 4 years. The range of returns and change from year to year can help you assess how risky the Fund has been in the past. It does not tell you how the Fund will perform in the future.



Best and worst 3-month returns

This table shows the best and worst returns for Series I securities of the Fund in a 3-month period over the past 4 years. The best and worst 3-month returns could be higher or lower in the future. Consider how much of a loss you could afford to take in a short period of time.

	Return	3 months ending	If you invested \$1,000 at the beginning of the period
Best return	5.9%	October 31, 2022	Your investment would rise to \$1,059.
Worst return	-5.6%	March 31, 2022	Your investment would drop to \$944.

Average return

A person who invested \$1,000 in the Series I securities at inception would have \$1,272 as of March 31, 2026. This is equal to an annual compounded return of approximately 4.9%.

Who is this Fund for?

You should consider investing in this Fund if you are comfortable with the risks for this investment and:

- your goal is to improve the risk-adjusted return of your portfolio;
- you intend this investment to be one component of a diversified investment portfolio; and
- you intend to hold your investment in an iProfile Discretionary Model with either Investors Group Financial Services Inc. or Investors Group Securities Inc. You cannot hold your investment in this Fund at an account with another dealer or outside of an iProfile Discretionary Model. If you wish to transfer your investment to another dealer or out of the iProfile Discretionary Model, you may have to redeem your Securities or switch into other iProfile Funds, which may have tax consequences.

A word about tax

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on the Fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the Fund in a registered plan, such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your Fund in a non-registered account, taxable fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

How much does it cost?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Series I securities of the Fund. The fees and expenses – including any commissions – can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. Sales charges

There are no sales charges payable when you buy securities of this series of the Fund.

2. Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. These expenses reduce the annual return of the Series.

As of September 30, 2025, the Series expenses were 0.96% of its value. This equals \$9.60 for every \$1,000 invested.

3. Other fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch securities of the Fund.

Fee	What you pay
Inappropriate Short-term trading fee	If you initiate a combination of purchases and redemptions, including switches into, or out from, the Fund within 30 days, your switches could have a detrimental effect on other Fund investors, and that may take advantage of Funds with investments priced in other time zones or illiquid investments that trade infrequently. We may charge you 2.00% of the amount you switch. This fee is payable to the Fund.
Excessive Short-term trading fee	If you initiate a combination of purchases and redemptions, including switches into, or out from, the Fund within 30 days, your switches could have a detrimental effect on other Fund investors, and we may charge you up to 2.00% of the amount you switch. This fee is payable to the Fund.
iProfile Advisory fee	You pay an advisory fee directly to the Principal Distributors for investment advice and administrative services if your investment is held with them. The advisory fee will be set out in your fee agreement with the applicable Principal Distributors, who may offer you a fee reduction. Please contact your IG Advisor for more information.

What if I change my mind?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual fund securities within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase, or in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, annual information form, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities law in your province or territory.
