What does the Fund invest in?

The Fund aims to provide secure current income, capital stability and liquidity by investing primarily in high-quality, short-term U.S. dollar-denominated money market investments of Canadian issuers. Generally, the Fund will not invest more than 50% of its assets in foreign securities. The charts below give you a snapshot of the Fund's investments on April 30, 2023. How risky is it?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money. One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund's returns change over time. This is called "volatility".

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

No guarantees

Like most mutual funds, this Fund doesn't have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

Risk rating

IG Wealth Management has rated the volatility of this Fund as **low**. This rating is based on how much the Fund's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.


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How has the Fund performed?

This section tells you how securities of the Fund have performed over the past 10 years. Returns are after Fund expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the Fund's returns.

Year-by-year returns

This chart shows how securities of the Fund performed in each of the past 10 years. The Fund did not drop in value in the past 10 years. The range of returns and change from year to year can help you assess how risky the Fund has been in the past. It does not tell you how the Fund will perform in the future.



Best and worst 3-month returns

This table shows the best and worst returns for securities of the Fund in a 3-month period over the past 10 years. The best and worst 3-month returns could be higher or lower in the future. Consider how much of a loss you could afford to take in a short period of time.

Average return

A person who invested U.S. \$1,000 in the securities 10 years ago would have U.S. \$1,053 as of April 30, 2023. This is equal to an annual compounded return of approximately 0.5%.

A word about tax

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on the Fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the Fund in a registered plan, such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your Fund in a non-registered account, taxable fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

Who is this Fund for?

You should consider investing in this Fund if you are comfortable with the risks for this investment and:

- your short-term investment goal is capital stability; and
- you are comfortable having an investment denominated in U.S. Dollars.

This series is generally available for investments through switches from series of the Fund and other IG Wealth Management Funds held in the same purchase option and for reinvestment of distributions. This series is available for purchase under the no load purchase option.

How much does it cost?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell securities of the Fund. The fees and expenses – including any commissions – can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1. Sales charges

You may have to choose a sales charge option when you buy this series of the Fund. Ask about the pros and cons of each option.

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2. Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. These expenses reduce the annual return of the Series.

As of March 31, 2023, the Series expenses were 1.01% of its value. This equals 10.10 for every 1.000 invested.

Fund expenses 1.01%

During the period, IG Wealth Management waived some of the Fund's expenses. If it had not done so, the MER would have been higher.

3. Other fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch securities of the Fund.

More about the trailing commission

The trailing commission is an ongoing commission. It is paid for as long as you own the Fund. It is for the services and advice that your IG Advisor provides to you.

IG Wealth Management pays the trailing commission to your IG Advisor. It is paid in whole or in part from the Fund's management fee and is based on the Canadian dollar value of your investment. The rate ranges between:

• 0.041% to 0.07% per year (CDN \$0.41 to \$0.70 per year for every CDN \$1,000 invested).

If your IG Advisor has been with us for more than four years, he or she may receive an additional annual payment of 0.006% to 0.009% of your investment (CDN \$0.06 to \$0.09 for every CDN \$1,000 invested).

Excessive Short-term If you initiate a combination of purchases and redemptions, including switches into, or out from, the Fund within 30 c switches could have a detrimental effect on other Fund investors, and we may charge you up to 2.00% of the amoun switch. This fee is payable to the Fund.				

What if I change my mind?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual fund securities within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase, or in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, annual information form, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities law in your province or territory.
