## What does the Fund invest in?

The Fund intends to provide investors with a diversified portfolio solution that provides long-term capital appreciation by investing in equity oriented Underlying Funds and/or directly in equity securities. Based on its assessment of economic and market conditions, the Portfolio Advisor may actively shift the allocation of the Fund’s exposures with respect to geography, sector, investment style, market capitalization, and/or currency. In addition to equity exposures, the Fund may also invest in other asset classes, including, but not limited to, alternative mutual funds.

## How risky is it?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund’s returns change over time. This is called “volatility”.

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

## Risk rating

IG Wealth Management has rated the volatility of this Fund as **medium**.

This rating is based on how much the Fund’s returns have changed from year to year. It doesn’t tell you how volatile the Fund will be in the future.

The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.

## No guarantees

Like most mutual funds, this Fund doesn’t have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

**How has the Fund performed?**

This section tells you how Series Tc securities of the Fund have performed since inception. Returns are after Fund expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the Fund’s returns.

**Year-by-year returns**

This information is not available because the Series has not completed a full calendar year.

**Best and worst 3-month returns**

This information is not available because the Series has not completed a full calendar year.

**Average return**

A person who invested \$1,000 in the Series Tc securities at inception would have \$1,121 as of June 30, 2020. This is equal to an annual compounded return of approximately 8.0%.

**Who is this Fund for?**

You should consider investing in this Fund if you are comfortable with the risks for this investment and:

- your long-term investment goal is a steady, monthly cash-flow;
- your investment will not be in a Registered Plan; and
- you are looking for a diversified portfolio in a single investment.

This series is generally available for investments through switches from Series C and Tc held in the same purchase option and for reinvestment of distributions. This series is also available for existing pre-authorized contribution arrangements under the no load purchase option.

**A word about tax**

In general, you’ll have to pay income tax on any money you make on the Fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the Fund in a registered plan, such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

As you hold your Fund in a non-registered account, taxable fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

**How much does it cost?**

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Series Tc securities of the Fund. The fees and expenses – including any commissions – can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

**1. Sales charges**

If you are eligible to purchase this series, you may have to choose a sales charge option. Ask about the pros and cons of each option.

## 2. Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. These expenses reduce the annual return of the Series.

For the year ended March 31, 2020, the annualized expenses of the Series totalled 2.98% of its value (about \$30 for every \$1,000 invested).

Clients are eligible to receive a rebate of some or all of the service fee paid by the Fund on their investment as outlined in the Fund's simplified prospectus.

## 3. Other fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch securities of the Fund.

Fee	What you pay
Inappropriate Short-term trading fee	If you initiate a combination of purchases and redemptions, including switches into, or out from, the Fund within 30 days, your switches could have a detrimental effect on other Fund investors, and that may take advantage of Funds with investments priced in other time zones or illiquid investments that trade infrequently. We may charge you 2.00% of the amount you switch. This fee is payable to the Fund.
Excessive Short-term trading fee	If you initiate a combination of purchases and redemptions, including switches into, or out from, the Fund within 30 days, your switches could have a detrimental effect on other Fund investors, and we may charge you up to 2.00% of the amount you switch. This fee is payable to the Fund.

## What if I change my mind?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual funds securities within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus or Fund Facts document, or
- cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of the purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase, or in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, annual information form, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities law in your province or territory.

For more information, see the securities law of your province or territory or ask a lawyer.

## More about the trailing commission

The trailing commission is an ongoing commission. It is paid for as long as you own the Fund. It is for the services and advice that your IG Consultant provides to you.

IG Wealth Management pays the trailing commission to your IG Consultant. It is paid in whole or in part from the Fund's management fee and is based on the value of your investment. The rate ranges between:

- 0.41% to 0.70% per year (about \$4 to \$7 per year for every \$1,000 invested).

If your IG Consultant has been with us for more than four years, he or she may receive an additional annual payment of 0.06% to 0.09% of your investment (about \$0.60 to \$0.90 for every \$1,000 invested).
